Visual and Digital Media Intern (unpaid, for credit – 20 hours per week, flexible schedule)

The visual and digital media intern will work under supervision of development staff to create primarily photo and video content and occasionally other forms of visual content to share stories about Habitat homeowners, volunteers and the overall low-income housing issues in Snohomish County. The intern's expertise with videography, photography and editing will share stories that will engage and teach the community about the issues our organization solves.

Tasks Include

- Shoot video and photos at project sites (Lynnwood and Everett Stores, Construction Site, Office, Special Events) and carry out interviews and additional shoots by appointment with our homeowners and volunteers to share their stories, edit videos and photos
- Create promotional and informational videos, images and print material to increase community awareness of our organization and to help with fundraising and volunteer recruitment
- Use various visual concepts and tools to share stories and increase public knowledge about our organization
- Work with and under supervision of development staff and other staff as needed to brainstorm and develop story and project ideas
- Must have occasional access to photo/video equipment (as needed) or have your own (a dslr camera required, additional equipment preferred), we will provide editing software and a computer for intern to use

- Ability to find and tell a story through digital and visual communications
- Strong writing and communication skills
- Video and photo experience, including editing
- Excellent interpersonal, interviewing and research skills
- Experienced with Adobe Creative Suite and FinalCut Pro or other video editing program
- Creative personality and strong ability to tell a story and to guide others in sharing their story
- Able to work at a desk and in the field
- Able to sit at a desk all day and handle large projects and multiple projects at once
- Mass media, journalism, visual media, digital media, visual journalism, communications, broadcast media/journalism, videography/photography, marketing and public relations and all related majors preferred, not required
